FACT Officers gather background information on referred youth and set up a time and meeting place to address gang and delinquency issues with the youth and his/her family. Our goal is to offer options for change.

MENTORING

The FACT Program finds positive role models and community leaders who are willing to share their life experiences and spend time with youth at FACT events.

CHARACTER BUILDING

An important goal of the FACT Program is to instill positive character traits and life skills lessons through positive learning opportunities and with the purpose of exposing youth to a different perspective other than a lifestyle of crime and gangs.
